

MOUNTING SUGGESTIONS:

Kawasaki Vulcan 1600 Classic/Nomad Tank Bib

Installation of Mustang tank bib:

- 1. Remove the seat, then remove the two mounting bolts at the base of the tank with a 12mm wench, then remove the three dash Allen bolts with a 4mm Allen wrench.
- 2. Lift the chrome cover off the tank, then lift the speedometer bracket just enough to slide the tank bib underneath. Align the square hole over the mounting boss, then push the speedometer bracket back into place.
- 3. Re-install the three dash bolts and tighten securely with a 4mm Allen wrench.
- 4. Push the two tank bolts through the holes in the base of the bib and re-install into the tank and frame. Tighten securely with a 12mm wrench.
- 5. Re-install the seat.
